ELIGIBILITY

This call for submission is open to — artists 18 years of age or older — artists 12 – 18 years of age.

Only original work created, conceived, and executed entirely by the artist and not previously exhibited at The Artist's Alliance or The Arts Center will be accepted.

This is a juried exhibition for artists working in all traditional and non-traditional 2D and 3D media.

Artwork must not exceed 48 inches in any dimension including the frame. Sculpture cannot exceed 30 inches in any dimension and must be light enough for one person to handle.

The Sponsors reserve the right to return work that is not of acceptable quality or that differs significantly from the photographic image.
